2024 Banners on Parade Call to Artists

Directions for Applying

- Entry is open to all California residents, individuals, groups, or clubs aged 16 and above. The submitted work must be original and not previously exhibited in Banners on Parade. Each person, group, or club can submit only one banner.
- The Banners on Parade (BOP) Committee will select entries from submitted applications. Chosen applicants will be notified by the BOP Committee, and their decisions are final. Selected applicants will paint their design on 30" x 60" canvas banners provided by the BOP Committee.
- The theme is <u>Seasonal Splendor</u> and artists are encouraged to adhere to this theme; this could be, for example, seasonal nature scenes such as green hills, wildflowers, colorful trees in fall, snow on trees
- The title of your banner should be *no more than 30 characters* (letters, numbers, spaces).
- Fill in page 1 and 2 of the application and provide a *color* drawing of your design on page 3 with as much detail as possible. **Make a copy of the entire application for your files.**
- Send the application (pages 1, 2, & 3) along with the entry fee of \$30 in a check made out to *Images of Hope*, to Paige Vansickle, 431 Turn Pike Rd., Folsom, CA 95630. Call Paige with any questions at 916-985-8996.

Guidelines for Painting

- The provided 30" x 60" banner has primer on both sides—the front, blank side for your original art and the back side with the pre-printed *Images of Hope* information.
- Use artist-grade acrylic paints only and paint your submitted design on the blank front side (to the upper and lower edges past the seams) and however you choose on the back (leaving the *Images of Hope* information and logo visible). Use thin layers of acrylic paint—the paint on the flexible canvas surface may crack if the paint is too thick. Sign the banner after completion in the front lower-right corner above the hemline.
 <u>Note</u>: before you paint, ensure that the banner is top-side up (turn the banner over to make sure that the logo pre-printed on that side is not upside down).
- Do not alter the banner in any way (no holes, piercing, or attached objects) and do not have any wording, obscene graphics, or commercial/religious/political advertising.
- <u>Important</u>: When paint is completely dry, seal the banner (both sides and edges) with 2 coats of UV protective sealer/varnish, such as *Golden Polymer Varnish* (with UVLS)

Make sure you fill out pages 1 and 2 of the application completely! Create a detailed color sketch/drawing on page 3 of the application!

- Artist understands that *Banners on Parade/Images of Hope El Dorado* shall continue to be the exclusive owner of their entire right, title and interest in the finished banner, including but not limited to, all derivative works based on the design of the banner if the finished banner is approved for exhibition.
- Artist agrees that due to the nature of the public display, *Images of Hope El Dorado* shall not be liable for any distortion, mutilation, modification or destruction of the finished banner by accident, act of God or person.
- Artist affirms that he/she is the sole creator of the design and that the design is an original work of art which does not infringe upon the copyrights/intellectual property rights of others, and that he/she has the unencumbered rights to make this assignment.
